

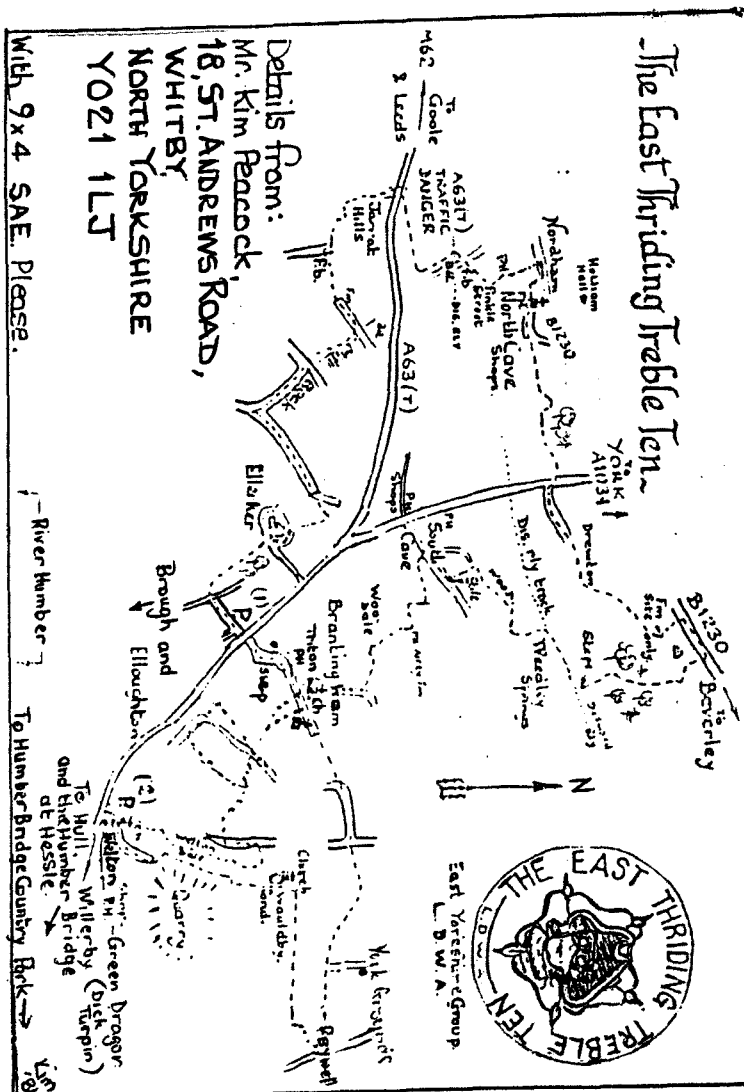

① Start at the bridge over the A63(T) (939292), on by the Triton Inn and Brantingham Church (944300), along the dale road to f.p. on L. (943306). Turn R. at farm (938306), down and up on f.p. to Mount Airey farm (936311). L. thro' fm, and f.p. down to rd. at S. Cave (926313). Approx. 3 miles. Little Wold lane to chalk rd. (934325). T.R. to stile on L., f.p. to dis. rly. at Weedy Springs (937330). T.R. to steps on L. along East Dale to flds and B1230 rd (939349). Approx 5 miles. Thro' gate on L. and f.p. down to Drewton Cottage (931335). Track to rd. T.R. to tr. on L. to Drewton fm. (913329). Fp. to rd. and N. Cave church (897327). 10 miles approx. T.R. at church, TL thro' gate alongside stream R. over stream to Nordham. Rd to "The Brick House", and f.p. on L. Over stream. to Sundial restaurant and White Hart pub. Leave rd. via Finkle St, cross flds to dis. rly. br. cross over stream, TL to T junc. of tracks, T.R., follow to A63(T) (880311).

② Cross over A63(T.) with care, to Jarrat Hills. Follow fm. tr. and rd to f.br. on L. (887302). Follow edge of fields with dyke on L. to Cave Common Fm. (894303). Rd to Mill Beck br. (898305). T.R. with beck on L. to rd. near Mill fm. (903297). Minor rd. to T. Junc. T.L. and on by sewage wks and glasshouses to trds nr. Ellerker (919300). Straight on to tr. nr. seat, on and R. across flds, beware of dog on long chain, keep conifer trees on L. Across fld to Ellerker, rd to T. Junc. T.R. and T.L. (925294) to f.p. alongside plantation, a fenced f.p.. To rd (933287) and back to start. (cars.). Approx. 18 miles. From (cars) start (939292) back thro' village of Brantingham, keep R. nr. pond and walk up steep rd. hill, Spout Hill at (948298). Turn R. thro' wood nr. top of hill. Fp. to Elloughton Dale rd. (949283). Cross rd. ascend to f.p.s junc. (957290). Straight!! on to Welton rd. (964288). T.L. to f.p. on R. (do not use concrete private rd.). Along fld. edge (bridleway) to stile on R. (968292). Thro' wood to Welton

③ Dale, and to Welton village (959272). T.L. before church, and up Chapel Hill to quarry, T.L. round quarry (965280). Over concrete rd. f.p. to Wauldby pond (970279). T.R. to Little Wauldby fm. (986295), T.L. to rd. nr. Raywell, T.L. before rd, follow tr. on by York Grounds + trks (973304), straight on to rd. after Botton Plantation, at (963304). Now on rd. to Green Lane (959304) and back down Spout Hill to Brantingham and the cars to finish. Approx (28 to 30 miles total.) O.S. Sheet 106 - Market Weighton. Obey the rules of the Country Code. All distances are approximate. There is no time limit, and the route can be walked over 1/2/3/4 days. A badge is available from Kim Peacock.

Conceived in the late 1960's by Kim Peacock this route eventually came into being in 1981. The walk starts and finishes at Welton, famous for the Green Dragon Inn which was one of the favourite haunts of highwayman Dick Turpin before he was captured and hanged at York. The figure-of-eight route winds its way round the rolling South Wolds country west of Hull taking in many of its delightful villages and dry dales. There are no restrictions on how the walk should be done and many walkers take two or three days.

It was common among the Norsemen of old to divide lands into three portions for the purposes of government, and their name for each portion was thridþung. This mysterious word means in our tongue "a third part" and from it arose the English word Thridings as companion to feorthing, another word which we use today in a very slightly altered form. But the difficulty of pronouncing distinctly and easily the combination "North Thriding" is evident, and the troublesome word suffered the same fate as commonly then befell the troublesome man - it got, quite naturally, beheaded.
