Furness Five Trigs Walk

37 km / 23 miles

800 m / 2600 ft of ascent

A walk in low Furness linking the highest points: Hoad Monument, Bank House Moor, High Haume, Yarlside and Birkrigg Common. You will walk a short section of the Cumbria Way and the Furness Boundary Walk, plus a delightfull section of Ulverston Canal, walking on open moorland with extensive views over the Duddon estuary and Lakeland hills, Birkrigg Common with its excellent views over the whole walk and Morecambe Bay. There is no set route but a possible route can be downloaded from the LDWA website.
