# 10 Publicity

Pauline gave us an update which led to a general discussion how we may allow new/potential members an opportunity to meet current members and find out about the group.

CT put forward the suggestion that we could run a series of relatively shorter walks that would either have a stop at a cafe or one at the end of the walk for a brew. She aready has five walks, that she could lead, that are 90% ready to go. (Great Hill, Winter Hill, Peel Tower, Cuerden Valley, Yarrow Valley) As well as the leader it would require some current members to attend in order to share their love and knowledge of the LDWA. These walks could probably be held, as an alternative to the longer walk, one Sunday every two months All current members would obviously be welcome but walks would also be suitable for people that don't have a full day to walk, or just fancy something a little shorter than normal. Just because we are Long distance walkers, doesn't exclude us from doing something shorter in addition to as our programme of longer walks. Even if we don't get any new members, the current members could still enjoy an extra walk out.

We could advertise the walks using the 'meet up' App, as well as our website and Facebook etc. **Action:** CT to investigate practicalities of using 'meet up'.
