and some problems reported to Footpath Officer.

With regard to 2024 – will we be able to run the HH? **RH**, **JB** and **MS** to form a sub-committee TBC.

Shotley Peninsula 50. 74 / 180 entries so far. 1st draft of route ready to be checked next week, no GPX at present. CPs booked but quality of wi-fi at Holbrook needs to be checked (wi-fi is very important at this CP), Raynet will not be needed. **GS** has a list 20 marshals and Norfolk & Suffolk have offered to help run 1 or 2 CPs, maybe they could run the early CPs to give E&H marshals more time to travel. Jane Audsley of N&S has kindly offered the use of her house as the dinner stop on the marshals.

Blackwater Marathon. The school is booked – we await the invoice. Goldhanger & Tollesbury CPs booked. Route to be reviewed late spring. The car park for the marshals now charges, so need to look for an alternative start point. In order to ensure wi-fi at the last CP, **RS** has suggested to Bill Bowers running the route the other way round for a change.

Challenge Event Badges. New badge for Shotley (order same time as BW) TBC after Tuesday route check. Plus, we should order more badges for the Stagger and new badges for the HH.
