2023 SUMMARY

- We offered 90 walks in 2023, despite several cancellations in response to rail strikes and occasional very poor weather.
- We averaged 13 people per walk.
- We had 28 walk leaders this year, including some from other groups (Surrey, Kent, Wiltshire, and Essex and Herts) who kindly cross-listed their walks with the London group.
- We cross-listed some of our walks with other LDWA groups when we were walking in their areas: Surrey, Sussex, Essex and Herts, Kent, and Beds, Bucks & Northants.
- Most of our leaders lead several walks per year. Ron Williamson (17), Gavin Fuller (16), and Jerome Ripp (11) led the most walks in 2023 and deserve our thanks.
