REPORT by Jeff Ellingham (& George Foot).

Three consecutive days of thick fog deterred some entrants, especially in badly affected areas, from making the journey to Witley. But those who chanced it found improved conditions, but the fog still obscured the views. This is now the 6th year running that we have had good weather for pedestrianism.

Perhaps the secret of the success of the Surrey Group's Winter Events, is the time of year. It is so full of surprises. A day in August is either fine or wet but otherwise unlikely to provide anything unexpected. I have never seen such thick frost on the trees, and the amazing white tracery was a wonder to behold. Even decaying wire fences had become things of beauty. The early part of the route was like wandering through a fairyland.

The ever increasing problems of drought bought a bonus, as most entrants finished with dry feet, clean trousers and very little mud on their shoes; this was indeed a new experience. The conditions underfoot were so good that times were a little quicker than last year.

The Walker's mass Start at 7.30, with the option of a later registered start, worked well. The Runners start was delayed this year until 8.30am, and not having had any complaints, I presume that no-one was badly inconvenienced by these faster moving entrants. I did have a report of discarded drink containers being seen up on Kettlebury Trig Point. I hope these did not belong to any Punchbowlers. As LDWA Events have been criticised for possibly encouraging erosion I hope that LDWA members did not exasperate the situation by dropping litter.

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The Entrants were full of praise for the Marshals, and I would like to add my own appreciation. I personally try to arrange a perfect LDWA 'day out'; but the Event cannot go ahead without Marshals, so I am very grateful to those who worked all day, as well as to those that chose a shorter route in order to help.

I would like to apologise to those 1991 Punchbowlers who recieved Certificates stating the distance to be only 30 miles. The route is of course a full 33 miles, but most of the certificates were written out a few days before the Event, and the writer mistakenly wrote 30 miles on all the ones he pre-prepared. Once again my apologies, and if anyone would like a fresh certificate I will be happy to oblige.

The only blemish on the day was the plumbing at the Start/Finish Hall. The water was very slow moving so that the Kitchen, Showers & Loo's all suffered. Apparently a plumber had fitted two new shower heads in the week and had presumably not left the system in the state that he had found it. The Hall Management assure me that the problem will be resolved by the time of our next Event on April 4th. If you don't feel that you could manage 62 miles just yet, let me know & I'll let you help out on one of the Checkpoints just to savour the atmosphere!

I cannot let this moment pass without paying tribute to the LDWA's co-founder Chris STEER who passed away peacefully on February 6th. Many tributes to him will appear in the next STRIDER, but I & the PUNCHBOWL Event owe a great deal to his help, advice and encouragement since the beginning. Chris's example has encouraged me in the past to keep the Event going during difficult times, and his memory will help me keep it going in the future. Chris STEER & Alan BLATCHFORD will never be forgotten.
