1	Introduction. John as the new Chair introduced the format for this evening's meeting. Hotpot to be served followed by Ian's brief summary of the reported footpath issue's on the Am. Walks programme (Neil) and financial summary (Ann).
2	Anglezarke Amble A member has put onto our Facebook comments about the bad state of some of the footpaths on the Amble route. Ian presented these comments with suggestions on how the issues commented on could be addressed by introducing diversions. After discussion it was agree that only one diversion should be introduced, and all entrants should be notified of this route alteration.
3	The Walks Programme Neil commented that the current programme was full until the 9 th April. The statistics were as follows: Summary figures given are: 13 walks since 1 st November with two more scheduled for the remainder of the month
	giving 15 in three months. An average of 5 per month, which over winter and including the Christmas break is a decent number. 3 weekend and 10 weekday walks. 6 Longer and 7 shorter.
	Longer – average mileage = 15 and on average 11 people attended.
	Shorter – average mileage 10 and on average 20 people attended.
	One member commented about the lack of 10 mile Tuesday walks? Neil responded that under his tenure as Chair he extended the walks from $9-13$ miles on the programme. The programme reflected this change. Neil also stated that in the future, he would not be sending out the programme but it would be listed on the Web page. With the exception of any last minute changes, which would be sent out to Members.
